INSTRUCT the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD), with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), and any other applicable City department, to provide a report with recommendations to the CRA/LA Bond Oversight Committee to allocate all remaining taxable CRA/LA EBP available to Council District One, including any earned interest, for various public improvements as identified in the Bond Expenditure Agreement and Bond Spending Plan for the Adelante Eastside Redevelopment Project Area.
- 2. INSTRUCT the LADOT to utilize all remaining taxable CRA/LA EBP available to Council District One from the Adelante Eastside Redevelopment Project Area, including any earned interest, to fund the Adelante Eastside Public Improvements Project upon Council approval of the forthcoming EWDD report.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.
