ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to allocating Community Redevelopment Agency of Los Angeles (CRA/LA) Excess Bond Proceeds (EBP) for graffiti abatement and 7th Street public improvements within the Westlake Recovery Redevelopment Project Area.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo - Huizar), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- INSTRUCT the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD), with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Office of Community Beautification (OCB), and any other applicable City department, to provide a report with recommendations to the CRA/LA Bond Oversight Committee to allocate \$300,000 in taxable CRA/LA EBP available to Council District One, for graffiti abatement and 7th Street public improvements as identified in the Bond Expenditure Agreement and Bond Spending Plan for the Westlake Recovery Redevelopment Project Area.
- INSTRUCT the OCB to utilize \$300,000 in taxable CRA/LA EBP available to Council District One from the Westlake Recovery Redevelopment Project Area, to fund the Westlake Graffiti Abatement Project upon Council approval of the forthcoming EWDD report.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on May 28, 2018, your Economic Development Committee considered a Motion (Cedillo - Huizar) relative to allocating CRA/LA EBP for graffiti abatement and 7th Street public improvements within the Westlake Recovery Redevelopment Project Area.
