Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Cedillo - Huizar), SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. INSTRUCT the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD), with the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Office of Community Beautification (OCB), and any other applicable City department, to provide a report with recommendations to the CRA/LA Bond Oversight Committee to allocate all remaining taxable CRA/LA EBP available to Council District One, including any earned interest, for various streetscape improvements as identified in the Bond Expenditure Agreement and Bond Spending Plan for the Wilshire Center/Koreatown Redevelopment Project Area.
- INSTRUCT the OCB to utilize all remaining taxable CRA/LA EBP available to Council
  District One from the Wilshire Center/Koreatown Redevelopment Project Area, including
  any earned interest, to fund various streetscape improvements upon Council approval of
  the forthcoming EWDD report.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.
