## Summary:

At its meeting held on February 10, 2015, the Planning and Land Use Management Committee considered the inclusion of the Laurel Terrace Street Trees located at Cantura Street from Vantage to Rhodes Avenues; Rhodes Avenue from Ventura Boulevard to Laurel Terrace in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments. The Urban Forestry Division in Public Works requested that the CHC report contain the following technical correction: most of the trees on these streets are not technically sycamores but are instead London Plane trees (Platanus acerifolia). After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendation and findings of the CHC relative to the inclusion of the Laurel Terrace Street Trees in the list of Historic-Cultural Monuments. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
