HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the evaluation of the property at 12901 Venice Boulevard as permanent supportive housing and continued use as a headquarters and independent living center by the Disability Community Resource Center (DCRC).

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin - Harris-Dawson):

- 1. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Department of City Planning, City Attorney, Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), along with any other relevant agencies or departments, in consultation with the management or Board of Directors of the DCRC, to evaluate the property at 12901 Venice Boulevard to determine its suitability for development as permanent supportive housing and continued use as a headquarters and independent living center by the DCRC.
- 2. INSTRUCT the CAO along with any other relevant departments, if the property is determined to be suitable for development as permanent supportive housing and continued use as a DCRC headquarters and independent living center, to provide options and make recommendations for the appropriate process to consider, solicit, or develop such a proposal.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on January 16, 2019, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Bonin - Harris-Dawson) relative to the evaluation of the property at 12901 Venice Boulevard as permanent supportive housing and continued use as a headquarters and independent living center by the DCRC.
