

## **MOTION**

On April 5, 2011, the Council approved the addition of Section 87.55 to Chapter VIII of the Los Angeles Municipal Code that establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles displaying a "For Sale" sign or placard advertising the private sale of that vehicle. After conducting a public hearing, Section 87.55 allows the City Council to amend this Section to include additional streets or public lands.

A large number of vehicles are consistently parked on both sides of North Lorena Street and of Evergreen Avenue between East Cesar Chavez Avenue and First Street; and on both sides of First Street and of East Cesar Chavez Avenue between Evergreen Avenue and North Lorena Street, for the sole purpose of displaying them for private sale. This situation is monopolizing on-street parking and creating visual blight in the Boyle Heights community surrounding the much used jogging and walking path around Evergreen Cemetery.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Council request the City Attorney to prepare and present an ordinance amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 87.55, which establishes regulations for the parking of vehicles for private sale on certain City streets or public lands, to prohibit the parking of such vehicles with a "For Sale" sign on both sides of North Lorena Street and of Evergreen Avenue between East Cesar Chavez Avenue and First Street; and on both sides of First Street and of East Cesar Chavez Avenue between Evergreen Avenue and North Lorena Street.
