Summary: The Atwater Village Neighborhood Council requests a delay of vote until community wide outreach to the public and the AVNC is provided which explains the EIFD structure: projects, boundaries, bonds, etc. This new state law allows cities to create/form financing districts which can use incremental increased property taxes and bonds for various projects, including brownfield restoration, infrastructure, low-income housing, commercial corridors and more. Funds cannot be used for operation and maintenance. This funding structure could be used for LA River restoration. The projects, and the scope and oversight of "river" district, need to be defined and presented to the community/public to promote accountability of such projects using tax and/or bond funds.
