<u>SUMMARY</u>

In a report to the Mayor and Council dated October 2, 2014, the City Clerk states that the fund balance for the Threat Preparedness Trust Fund No. 46M was \$0.00 as of June 30, 2013. The Fund realized net revenue in the amount of \$0.00, and total expenditures and encumbrances in the amount of \$0.00, leaving a balance of \$0.00 as of June 30, 2014. According to the City Clerk, the Fund was established in 2002 for the receipt and disbursements of parking revenues generated from the Department of General Services parking located at First and Main Streets and any other monies allocated by the Council and Mayor, to be used to fund the City's anti-terrorism, threat preparedness, and disaster readiness capabilities.

At its meeting held December 12, 2014, the Public Safety Committee recommended that Council approve the City Clerk's report.
