From CF 14-1371-S1 Economic analysis:</p> <p><b>WE THEREFORE MOVE</b> that the City Administrative Office (CAO) - Office of Economic Analysis, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the Economic Workforce Development Department, be instructed to procure an economic analysis of the minimum wage proposal, as referenced by Council Files: 14-1371 and 14-1371-S1, and include its effects on the local economy, employment opportunities, nonprofits, small businesses and any other unintended consequences including the reduction of worker benefits and hours; and <b>WE FURTHER MOVE</b> that the CAO and CLA evaluate the pros and cons of categorical exemptions and other creative impact mitigations for specific industries with a special emphasis on nonprofits, alternative methods for measuring and implementing automatic wage increases, the establishment of a base and a ceiling on automatic wage increases, implementation timelines on the minimum wage ordinance, and criteria related to small businesses, including the allowance of counting the total taxable compensation towards the minimum wage and consideration of a slower phase in for the wage requirement; and <b>WE FURTHER MOVE</b> that the CLA and CAO include in its report to the City Council how the citywide minimum wage will be monitored, implemented, and enforced. <b>WE FURTHER MOVE</b> that the requested information be included in the study requested by CF: 14-1371 and 14-1371-S1.</p>	Bob Peppermuller
