LA Sanitation (LASAN) crews continue to work diligently in protecting the public health and environment across the City of Los Angeles. In addition to addressing recycling and waste generation by residents, LASAN implements several initiatives to help maintain the quality of life in neighborhoods via its Livability and Environmental Quality Program.

Recent reports indicate a significant backlog of service requests in the Clean Streets initiative. As conversations proceed for addressing and improving service delivery in the upcoming budget cycle, many neighborhoods across the City are in need of immediate attention now. LASAN should provide the Council with recommendations and options to begin tackling the service request backlog now, in parallel to the continuing discussions over the upcoming fiscal year budget program.

I THEREFORE MOVE that LASAN be instructed to report with options and recommendations to further address the Clean Streets initiative backlog in the current fiscal year, including an analysis of how an immediate effort would complement LASAN's proposed strategy for the upcoming fiscal year.
