Dear Council Members,

Recently, several motions have been introduced to City Council that propose changes to the way the City and region handle the homeless crisis. The Del Rey Neighborhood Council has long supported homeless solutions that have a direct impact on the community; thoughtful and fact based reforms to existing systems; and an even playing field for all localities so that Los Angeles is not left with any undue burden regionally.

Therefore, at our July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019 meeting, the Del Rey NC passed by a vote of 9-0 the following motions:

***‘The Del Rey NC supports CF 14-0655 which asks for a report on the status and possible updates to the Coordinated Entry System.***

***The Del Rey NC supports 14-1499 (as amended) which calls for a review of the Bureau of Sanitation’s cleanup policies and their effectiveness.***

***The Del Rey NC supports CF 19-0719 which calls for a pilot sanitation program in CD11.***

***The Del Rey NC supports CF 19-0602 which supports compelling other localities to follow the same court decisions LA must in its response to homelessness.’***
