FUBLIC WORKS & GANG REDUCTION

The Sixth Street Viaduct Replacement Project (Project) is a \$482 million dollar replacement of the old Sixth Street Viaduct (Viaduct), with a new iconic 3,500 linear foot viaduct over the Los Angeles River. In order to construct the new Project, the City acquired properties adjacent to and beneath the old Viaduct for the construction of a new structure in keeping with State and Federal Highway standards.

Upon the completion of the new Viaduct, the Department of Public Works will retain access underneath and adjacent to the Viaduct for inspection and maintenance of the Viaduct. The Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) has also agreed to be the City agency designated with the operation and maintenance responsibilities, for park purposes, of the land acquired by the City for the Project. To effectuate this shared use, the Bureau of Engineering must be authorized and directed to complete a non-financial transfer of jurisdiction of those properties acquired for Project purposes to the ownership and control of RAP. Such actions to include the execution of all necessary documents to effectuate the transfer of the acquired properties.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering, the Department of Recreation and Parks, and the Department of General Services be instructed, with the assistance and cooperation of the City Attorney and City Administrative Officer, to undertake all actions necessary to effectuate a non-financial transfer of jurisdiction of those properties acquired by Department of Public Works, Bureau of Engineering, for the Sixth Street Viaduct Replacement Project, including all appropriate survey data, creation of the correct legal description, preparation and review of related title documents, and acquiring other necessary approvals.
