

RULES, ELECTIONS, AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to requesting the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) to implement a program notifying parents and guardians about the Safe Storage of Handguns Ordinance.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Krekorian - Martinez - Harris-Dawson), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE that the City of Los Angeles hereby requests the LAUSD to implement a program that notifies parents and guardians about the Safe Storage of Handguns Ordinance and requests them to sign an acknowledgment stating that, if they own a gun, they understand the importance of safely storing it and commit to doing so.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on November 16, 2018, the Rules, Elections, and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Krekorian - Martinez - Harris-Dawson) relative to requesting the LAUSD to implement a program that notifies parents and guardians about the Safe Storage of Handguns Ordinance and requests them to sign an acknowledgment stating that, if they own a gun, they understand the importance of safely storing it and commit to doing so. The Resolution, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information.

After consideration, and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
