PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to waiving the Parking Occupancy Tax Bond requirement for parking facilities where credit cards are offered to daily customers.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Buscaino - Englander - Parks):

1. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to waive the Parking Occupancy Tax Bond requirement for parking facilities where credit cards are offered to daily customers, provided the operator continues to report timely and accurately, and provides access to electronic records of credit card transactions to the Office of Finance.
2. INSTRUCT the Office of Finance, Police Commission, Information Technology Agency and REQUEST the City Attorney to report on the best available technology solutions to identify the number of private parking lots or structures in the City, as well as vacant land that may be used as auto park operations.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on April 19, 2016, your Public Safety Committee considered a Motion (Buscaino - Englander - Parks) relative to preparing an Ordinance to impose a requirement on all private parking operators in the City to employ the use of revenue control equipment. During the discussion of the item, Councilmember Buscaino requested that the first recommendation be modified to request the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance to waive the Parking Occupancy Tax Bond requirement for parking facilities where credit cards are offered to daily customers, provided the operator continues to report timely and accurately, and provides access to electronic records of credit card transactions to the Office of Finance. An opportunity for public comment was held. After a brief discussion, the Committee moved to approve the recommendations contained in the Motion as modified, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
