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Comments for Public Posting: Please don't limit the number of guests that I may host per night. I depend on this income. Now that the new year is here, my medicare only pays half of my deductible for my HIV meds. (Triumeq) That means that on top of all my other expenses, including a \$3000/month mortgage payment, I have to pay \$1200/month for my meds for the next 3 months!!! I don't qualify for the ADAP (aids drug assistance program) and I am no longer collecting SSDI. I'm not asking for a handout. I'm only asking that I be allowed to continue doing what I've been doing for the last 7 years. Sharing the extra rooms in my home with people I choose to live with, and not be told that am only allowed to rent for a limited number of days short term. This Home Sharing ordinance is totally unfair to people in my situation. I'm not a 'rich greedy landlord'. This ordinance was intended to stop homes from being taken off the market. However my bedrooms are not part of the housing stock, regardless of Matthew Glesne and the planning department's agenda. This ordinance is already causing me to deplete the only savings that I've been able to accumulate. I've always paid my taxes, I've been registered with the office of finance for over 6 years, and now I'm being penalized for following the rules. This ordinance is cruel and crude. Someone please amend this ordinance to remove the cap on number of guests who stay per night in MY OWN HOME!!
