REQUEST FOR REPORT BACK

On June 13, 2017, the Planning and Land Use Management (PLUM) Committee considered a report from the Los Angeles City Planning Commission relative to a proposed Ordinance (Home Sharing Ordinance), as amended by the Housing Committee on December 7, 2016, regarding amending the Los Angeles Municipal Code and the Los Angeles Administrative Code for the purpose of imposing regulations to permit sharing of primary residences (short-term rentals).

During the discussion, the PLUM Committee continued the matter and requested the Department of City Planning and the Housing and Community Investment Department to report on the following:

- An analysis of the current state of short-term rentals in the City, including but not limited to the
 percentage of impacted housing units, concentration areas Citywide and percentage of
 covenanted rental housing.
- 2. Potential revenue impact consistent with proposed draft regulations and variations thereof.
- 3. The number of nuisance calls that were based upon short-term rentals.
- 4. The categories of fee structures, including registration process, enforcement and primary guidelines, and explore best practices with other cities.
- 5. Shared Economy and the effect on the loss of affordability.
