Dear Councilman Bonin-

I attended the City Council meeting last week on December 11, where the Short Term Rental Ordinance was voted on.

Although I was #2 on the speaker sign up list, I was not given the opportunity to speak.

Here are the remarks I would have made had I been permitted to give my comment:

I am a short-term rental host in Venice. My wife and I share a guest room in our home of 35 years to make ends meet.

Thank you for listening to the thousands of hosts who need to share their homes yearround and for creating a way for us to do that.

We appreciate your keeping the registration fee manageable, \$89 dollars for the first 120 days. But the \$850 dollar fee to lift that cap is exorbitant and unfair.

Once the work of registering me is complete, for the initial \$89 bucks, does it really cost *ten times* that amount to administer my listing for the remainder of the year?

No, it doesn't.

Imposing a per-night surcharge intensifies the burden on the people who are sharing their homes merely to survive in these trying economic times.

I am retired and living on a fixed income as are many hosts in Los Angeles. We share our homes out of financial necessity. Requiring us to pay thousands of dollars a year to do so is nothing less than civic extortion.

Lower the fee for year-round home sharing and eliminate the per-night surcharge.
