This simple fact has helped me so much. It has been a wonderful experience. Not only do I have help with my bills, I also have met all kinds of wonderful people from around the globe. They tell me they love home-sharing because they can stay longer in the city and afford to do more things.

They frequent the smaller markets and restaurants in my neighborhood and I think that's a win-win for everyone!

I have also been able to do some really nice drought tolerant landscaping with the extra money I get, and this has reduced my DWP bill.

I find it's been a very rewarding experience. I would like to rent my other room out too, but my son needs a place to come home to! I'm so glad I found home sharing.
