PUBLIC WORKS AND GANG REDUCTION COMMITTEE REPORT and ORDINANCE FIRST CONSIDERATION relative to amending Section 56.11, Article 6, Chapter V of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to prohibit the storage of personal property in public areas.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

- 1. PRESENT and ADOPT the accompanying ORDINANCE amending Section 56.11, Article 6, Chapter V of the LAMC to prohibit the storage of personal property in public areas.
- 2. INSTRUCT the Board of Public Works to report in 60 days with recommendations on how to streamline and expedite the removal process.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on February 18, 2015, the Public Works and Gang Reduction Committee considered a City Attorney report and Ordinance relative to amending Section 56.11, Article 6, Chapter V of the LAMC to prohibit the storage of personal property in public areas.

The Committee first recessed the open meeting to hear from the City Attorney's Office in closed session about the confidential matters pertaining to this item. When the Committee members returned to open session, City Attorney staff gave an overview of the item. An opportunity for public comment was held. During the discussion of the item the Chair requested to add the recommendation that the Board of Public Works report in 60 days with recommendations on how to streamline and expedite the removal process. After further considering the item, the Committee moved to approve the Ordinance and the recommendation from the Chair as detailed above.

This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
