TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to technical revisions of the 2015 Los Angeles County Metropolitan Authority (Metro) Call for Projects list of proposed projects for the City of Los Angeles.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE the final list of proposed projects submitted to Metro for the 2015 Call for Projects grants attached to the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) report to Council dated May 21, 2015.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The LADOT reports that this action will not impact the General Fund. For projects awarded grant funding by Metro, City staff will identify the required matching funds and staff resources through the annual budget process.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

<u>SUMMARY</u>

In the report to Council dated May 21, 2015, LADOT presents a revised list of proposed projects to be submitted to Metro for the 2015 Call for Projects grant awards. LADOT reports that on December 16, 2015, Council authorized the Department to submit grant applications to Metro for funding from the 2015 Call for Projects. On January 16, 2015, Council amended the grant application list to remove one project in Council District 1. Later, Council District 13 requested that the Hollywood First-Last Mile Pedestrian Connections - Yucca to Argyle Street project be deleted from the City's approved project list. Also, LADOT staff identified changes to the cost estimates and scope descriptions for several projects that necessitated the revisions to the match funds and grant requests in the City's approved project list.

At its meeting held May 27, 2015, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve the revised list of projects to be submitted on behalf of the City for Metro's 2015 Call for Projects grant awards.
