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PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Seventh Amendment to the contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for maintenance and support for the Alarm and Permit Management System (APMS).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to negotiate and execute a Seventh Amendment to the professional services agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. (C-114355) in the amount of \$1,599,857 for the maintenance and support of the APMS from May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2022, subject to the review and approval by the City Attorney as to form.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The City Administrative Officer reports that there will be no additional impact to the General Fund associated with the proposed Seventh Amendment to the professional services agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. Funding has already been provided and is available in the LAPD's Contractual Services account. Execution of this contract complies with the City's Financial Policies in that contract expenditures will be limited to the use of approved budgeted funds.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 13, 2018, your Public Safety Committee considered a CAO report relative to the Seventh Amendment to the contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for maintenance and support for the APMS. The CAO reports that the LAPD is requesting authority to negotiate and execute a Seventh Amendment to the professional services agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. The proposed Seventh Amendment will provide an additional \$1,599,857 to the existing contract amount of \$3,747,924 for a total contract amount of \$5,347,781.

The Seventh Amendment is necessary to provide additional funding to upgrade the CryWolf Server (\$146,611) and for the maintenance costs (\$1,453,246) for the APMS from May 1, 2017 through April 30, 2022. In accordance with Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5(b)(2), Council approval is required to execute the proposed Seventh Amendment as the cumulative term of the contract exceeds three years.

After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation presented in the CAO transmittal, as detailed above.

This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
