**SUBJECT:** REQUEST FOR APPROVAL OF FIFTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. C-114355 WITH MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC.

**RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

1. That the Board of Police Commissioners (Board) REVIEW and APPROVE the attached Fifth Amendment to Contract No. C-114355.
2. That the Board TRANSMIT the Agreement to the Mayor's Office for review and approval.
3. That the Board AUTHORIZE the Chief of Police to execute the Amendment upon Mayoral approval.

**DISCUSSION**

In August 2008, the City of Los Angeles (City) and Motorola entered into a contract for the provision of an Alarm and Permit Management System (APMS). In June 2009, Motorola successfully implemented the new APMS. An amendment in June 2010 provided for the implementation of an interface to a web-based Alarm School module. The City wishes to continue maintenance of the APMS and Alarm School interface; therefore, the parties have agreed to this Fifth Amendment adding continued maintenance.

This Fifth Amendment to the Agreement will provide for the continued maintenance of the APMS and Alarm School interface through April 30, 2017. This maintenance is valued at \$726,903 and will increase the current contract value of \$2,667,073 to a total contract value of \$3,393,976.

Information Technology Bureau (ITB) requests that the Chief of Police review, approve, and transmit to the Board of Police Commissioners the attached Fifth Amendment to Contract No. C-114355 with Motorola Solutions, Inc. (Motorola) to provide maintenance of the Alarm and Permit Management System (APMS) and web-based Alarm School Module Interface. ITB further requests that the Chief of Police be authorized to execute the Amendment; which has been reviewed and approved as to form by the City Attorney.

**FIFTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NO. C-114355  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES  
AND  
MOTOROLA SOLUTIONS, INC.  
TO ENHANCE THE ALARM AND PERMIT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**

This is the **FIFTH AMENDMENT** to Contract No. C-114355 between the City of Los Angeles (herein referred to as "City"), acting by and through the Los Angeles Police Department (hereinafter referred to as "LAPD" or "Customer") and Motorola Solutions, Inc., (hereinafter referred to as "Motorola"), to continue maintenance for the Alarm and Permit Management System ("System") and the System's Alarm School Interface.

**RECITALS**

On August 28, 2008, City and Motorola entered into a contract for the provision of an Alarm and Permit Management System (Contract No. C-114355) ("Original Agreement"); and

On June 15, 2009, Motorola successfully implemented the new Alarm and Permit Management System; and

On June 24, 2010, City amended the Original Agreement to include an interface with the System for a web-based Alarm School ("Alarm School Interface"), which Contractor implemented; and

The City wishes to continue maintenance of the System and Alarm School Interface; and

The total amended System maintenance funds for the additional Fifth Amendment value of \$726,903 are to be added to the current contract amount of \$2,667,073 for a total contract amount of \$3,393,976; and

Motorola is willing to perform the work under the terms and conditions of this Amendment.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the parties hereby agree to amend Contract No. C-114355 to continue the maintenance to the System and Alarm School Interface and mutually agree as follows:

**1. ARTICLE II. TERM AND SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED**

**A. Time of Performance.**

The term of the fourth amendment remains unchanged.

**B. SECTION B, Purpose of the Agreement and Services to be Provided** is hereby amended to add the following new paragraph:

"The purpose of this Fifth Amendment is to add additional money to the Agreement in order for Motorola to provide maintenance for the Alarm and Permit Management System and Alarm School Interface."

**2. ARTICLE III. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**Section B.1, Payment Terms**, is hereby amended to increase the amount of compensation the City will pay Motorola for services to be performed, as specified in this Agreement, by Seven Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Three Dollars (\$726,903), increasing the existing Project Compensation Amount to Three Million Three Hundred Ninety-Three Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars (\$3,393,976). Based upon Exhibit 1 below, the City will be invoiced annually for the System and Alarm School Interface maintenance costs.

**3. Maintenance Schedule and Costs**

**A. Maintenance.** The City will purchase Maintenance and Support Services at the following rates:
