Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Harris-Dawson - Huizar), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for Los Angeles County's efforts to amend State law to grant counties the authority to seek voter approval of a tax on personal income above \$1,000,000 per year to combat homelessness.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on May 27, 2016, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (Harris-Dawson - Huizar) and a report from the CLA relative to establishing the City's position on Los Angeles County's efforts to amend State law to grant counties the authority to seek voter approval of a tax on personal income above \$1,000,000 per year to combat homelessness. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
