ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 State Legislative Program OPPOSITION to SB 608 (Liu), the Right to Rest Act, which would prevent local jurisdictions from enforcing laws against camping on sidewalks, in parks and in vehicles parked on public streets.
