

RULES, ELECTIONS, INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline through the lands of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (O'Farrell - Wesson - et al.), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's Federal Legislative Program, SUPPORT for legislation or administrative action that upholds the rights of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe and denies the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline through their lands.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

### SUMMARY

At a special meeting held on September 30, 2016, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (O'Farrell - Wesson - et al.) and a report from the CLA relative to establishing the City's position regarding legislation or administrative action that upholds the rights of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe and denies the construction of the Dakota Access Pipeline through their lands. The CLA report attached to the Council file provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution.

After consideration and after providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
