

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 474 (Brown and Thurmond) relative to State Supplementary Payment amounts.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Koretz - Krekorian), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 474 (Brown and Thurmond) which would require that State Supplementary Payment amounts to elderly, blind, and/or disabled individuals to be readjusted and increased annually.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst. The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its meeting of June 19, 2015, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Parks - Koretz) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position to support AB 48 (Stone) which would prohibit a person or entity from selling or giving another person a cigarette utilizing a single-use filter, and for SB 151 (Hernandez) which would increase the minimum legal age to purchase or consume tobacco from 18 to 21. The CLA report, attached to the Council file, provides additional background information and a summary of the Resolution. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council adopt the accompanying Resolution. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
