<u>SUMMARY</u>

At its meeting of June 19, 2015, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered Resolution (Buscaino - Cedillo) and a CLA report relative to establishing the City's position to SUPPORT of SB 317, The Safe Neighborhood Parks, Rivers, and Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2016, which would authorize the issuance of bonds in the total amount \$2.45 billion to finance a safe neighborhood parks, rivers, and coastal protection programoppose legislation that adopts new rules prohibiting the reallocation of Social Security payroll taxes.
