Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Ryu - Wesson), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION to include in the City's 2015-16 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 2663 (Cooper) which would appropriate additional funds for the After School Education and Safety Program and require funds to increase as the Consumer Price Index increases.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on March 18, 2016, the Rules, Elections, Intergovernmental Relations, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Resolution (Ryu - Wesson) and a report from the CLA relative to establishing the City's position regarding AB 2663 (Cooper) which would appropriate additional funds for the After School Education and Safety Program and require funds to increase as the Consumer Price Index increases.
