RECOMMENDED ACTIONS

- 1. That the Board of Police Commissioners REVIEW and APPROVE the attached application for Special Reward Payment.
- 2. That the Board TRANSMIT to the Mayor and City Council the Application for Special Reward Payment for review and approval.

DISCUSSION

It is requested that the Board approve and transmit to Council the recommendation that an approved reward offer be paid to the witness for providing information instrumental to the apprehension and conviction of Kenyata Blake in the murder of Maria Elena Rivas, Los Angeles City Council File No. 15-0010-S1.

On Monday, December 22, 2014, at 1830 hours, Maria Elena Rivas, 62-years old, was walking home from the Ralphs Super Market at 2600 South Vermont Avenue. Ms. Rivas had stopped at the market on her way home from work and had purchased groceries for the upcoming holiday. While walking west on Adams Boulevard near Catalina Avenue, a few blocks from the market, Ms. Rivas was robbed of her purse. During the attack, the suspects fatally stabbed Ms. Rivas in the back and left her lying at the curb. A passerby called 911, and Ms. Rivas was taken by ambulance to California Hospital where she was pronounced dead.

On January 26, 2015, the witness came forward and provided critical information that directly resulted in the arrest of the perpetrators on that same day. The case was subsequently filed (Court Case No. BA433216), and the witness testified against one of the two defendants at trial; which contributed to a jury-verdict of guilty on April 15, 2019. This defendant has been sentenced to life in prison without the possibility for parole. An additional defendant remains incustody, but has been found mentally unfit to stand trial.

It is the opinion of the investigating officer that the murder of Maria Elena Rivas would most likely have remained unsolved, if not for the information provided by the witness. Additionally, testimony in court against the defendant was instrumental in obtaining a conviction.



MOTION: CITY CLISEX SOE PLACEMENT ON KENT

On December 22, 2014 at approximately 6:30 p.m., 62-yeat-old Maria Elena Rivas was walking home from the Ralph's grocery store located at 2600 South Vermont Avenue in Los Angeles, where she had stopped to purchase groceries for the upcoming holiday. As she was walking west on Adams Boulevard near Catalina Avenue, a few blocks from the Ralph's, she was attacked and robbed of her purse. During this attack, she was fatally stabbed by her assailant or assailants. Detectives are continuing to investigate this case, and hope that a monetary reward compels members of the public to provide information on this crime.

The person(s) responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of Maria Elena Rivas.

I THEREFORE MOVE that by adoption of this Motion, the City Council provide an offer of reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of Maria Elena Rivas on December 22, 2014, and in support thereof, make the following findings pursuant to Division 19, Chapter 12, Article 1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code:

- That the death of Ms. Rivas was caused by the willful misconduct of one or more persons. 1.
- 2. That this offer of reward is consistent with and taken for the immediate protection of the public peace, health and safety of local residents, as well as visitors to the City, and is consistent with the need to arrest and convict the person or persons who, because of not being apprehended, could by their actions further terrorize and present a continuing and immediate menace to the rights of persons in the City.
- 3. That what happened to the victim is an especially disturbing crime and therefore, as a matter of public policy, the City hereby offers a reward as an added inducement for persons to come forward with information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the death of Maria Elena Rivas.
- That the sum of \$50,000 shall be the aggregate maximum sum of any payment or payments of a City reward 4. in this instance.
- That the offer of reward shall be in effect for six months from the date of the advertisement of the reward by 5. the City Clerk.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to cause notices and/or advertisements to be duly published according to the requirements of Division 19, Chapter 12, Article 1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, and to thereby cause the offer of reward to become effective.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to publish the reward notice in the "Our Weekly" and "LA Watts Times," in addition to the regular publications used by the City Clerk for reward notices, to ensure adequate community notice.
