The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$75,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the MASSIVE FIRE IN THE UNDER-CONSTRUCTION DAVINCI BUILDING, in the City of Los Angeles. In the early morning hours of December 8, 2014, a structure fire broke out at the under-construction DaVinci apartments, located at 906 Fremont Avenue in Downtown Los Angeles. The fire spread quickly, completely destroying the apartment building and causing significant damage to the 110 freeway and adjacent buildings. Luckily, no one was injured or killed in the fire, which caused between \$25 and \$30 million in damages. Fire Department (LAFD) investigators, assisted by detectives from the Police Department (LAPD) and specialists from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives National Response Team (ATF/NRT) have determined that the fire was deliberately started. Investigators believe a monetary reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the person or persons responsible for setting the blaze. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, JULY 31, 2015.



El fuego se extendió rápidamente, destruyendo completamente el edificio de apartamentos y causando un daño significativo a la autopista 110 y edificios adyacentes. Afortunadamente, nadie resultó herido o muerto en el incendio, que causó entre \$25 y \$30 millones en daños y perjuicios. Investigadores del Departamento de Bomberos (LAFD), asistidos por los detectives del Departamento de Policía (LAPD) y especialistas del Equipo de Respuesta Nacional de la Oficina de Alcohol, Tabaco, Armas de Fuego y Explosivos (ATF/NFRT, por sus siglas en inglés) ha determinado que el fuego fue provocado deliberadamente. Los investigadores creen que una recompensa monetaria puede obligar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información sobre la identidad de la persona o personas responsables de crear el incendio.
