Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Blumenfield - Buscaino):

REQUEST the City Attorney, in consultation with the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety, to prepare and present an ordinance to require new cellular communications towers to be constructed to satisfy therequirements of an "Importance Factor" of 1.5, which mirrors the standard currently required for public safety facilities.

## Summary:
