<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The CAO reports that the costs associated with the construction of facilities under the Proposition O Program will be paid through the issuance of \$500 million in general obligation bonds, interest earnings, and grant reimbursements. There is no anticipated cost to the General Fund for design and construction. It is anticipated that operation and maintenance costs for the completed facilities will be programmed into the City's annual budget process.
