HOUSING COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities (AHSC) Program.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Bonin for Cedillo - Buscaino):

- 1. INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA) to report on the recently approved AHSC Program regulations, the application process, and the process by which the City of Los Angeles may recommend projects for funding.
- 2. INSTRUCT the HCIDLA and the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) to coordinate a working group with all relevant City departments, and report.
- 3. INSTRUCT the CLA and the HCIDLA to report on the prioritized projects.
- 4. INSTRUCT the CLA, in conjunction with the HCIDLA, to negotiate a Memorandum of Understanding between the Southern California Association of Governments and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transit Authority relative to moving forward.
