HOLLY L. WOLCOTT CITY CLERK INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of the parcel located at 2000 North Fuller Avenue for the expansion of Runyon Canyon Park.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Ryu – O'Farrell):

- 1. DIRECT the Department of General Services (GSD) to conduct a Class A appraisal of the property at 2000 North Fuller Avenue in Runyon Canyon Park.
- 2. INSTRUCT the Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP), with the assistance of any other relevant departments, to report with a status update on the proposed donation of this parcel and a plan to accept the property donation and implement an expansion of Runyon Canyon Park.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On October 11, 2017, Council considered Motion (Ryu – O'Farrell) relative to the donation of the parcel located at 2000 North Fuller Avenue. Motion states that the private owner of the East Trail Steps and the adjacent trail in Runyon Canyon Park offered to donate the steps, trail and surrounding property to the City. The property is approximately one acre. Motion movers recommend that RAP prepare an implementation plan to accept and connect this parcel to Runyon Canyon Park, and that GSD appraise the property. Council referred Motion to the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held January 23, 2018, the Information, Technology, and General Services Committee recommended that Council approve Motion's recommendation.
