Dear Honorable Mayor and Councilmembers,

I am writing to support the establishment of the HPOZ in Miracle Mile with OLYPMIC STREET and all streets above Eighth INTACT. Removing these streets defeats the purpose of a honoring a city and culture that has plenty of historic monuments. If you remove these streets the following will occur:

1. We lose over **60 historical properties** that can be decimated.
2. **Failing Infrastructure:** Higher density in those areas will create more traffic and infrastructure does NOT support this.
3. You will be **REMOVING AFFORDABLE HOUSING:** Over 500 rent stabilized apartments are at risk for people who desperately need to keep affordable housing.

It has been unfortunate that the opposition groups have solicited people within the neighborhood and in doing so they have spread misinformation and scare tactics to our residents. If you look around at all the other HPOZ's, including the newest, our neighbor, Carthay Square, they all prosper and do very well.
