I work in the healthcare industry and need the closest access as possible to the Westside hospitals. Santa Monica, West LA, Culver City, and Century City are no longer affordable, especially for working class citizens who are seeking higher education in healthcare, an industry requiring more than 60 hour workweeks.

This is the last beacon of affordable housing in a safe region of LA County, and living in affordable housing in the Miracle Mile allows me to remain of service in the surgical healthcare industry to the residents of Bel Air, Beverly Hills, and Pacific Palisades as well as the families of South Central and East LA, not to mention patients from all over the country. Miracle Mile will truly lose its miraculous spirit if 500 rent stabilized apartments are excluded from HPOZ.
