

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of the in-kind donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of 21 crime scene preservation canopies for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of 21 crime scene preservation canopies valued at \$18,312, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated August 18, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the acceptance of the in-kind donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of 21 crime scene preservation canopies for the LAPD. The LAPD reports that the Los Angeles Police Foundation will provide the LAPD with 21 crime scene preservation canopies. The canopies will be distributed to each of the geographic Areas under Operations-Central, West, and Valley Bureaus, including the LAPD's four traffic divisions. The canopies will benefit the LAPD by assisting investigators in the preservations of evidence at crime scenes and by helping preserve the dignity of the victims and their families. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve to the acceptance of the in-kind donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of 21 crime scene preservation canopies for the LAPD, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
