DISCUSSION

The donation will benefit the Los Angeles Police Department (Department) by providing an upgrade to Robbery Homicide Division's Situation Room. Robbery Homicide Division (RHD) investigates high-profile incidents that occur in the City of Los Angeles. The ability to assemble, organize and deploy large numbers of investigators during a prolonged or multi-agency event is an integral part of the major case management strategy it employs. The donation will allow RHD to more efficiently display, disseminate, and act on pertinent information received from the public and other law enforcement agencies in real-time.

The equipment and installation has been reviewed and approved by both Information Technology Bureau and Facilities Management Division for use by the Department. There will be a one year warranty for the labor and equipment provided by the vendor. When the warranty expires, maintenance and repairs will be sought through future donations. No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Los Angeles Police Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Los Angeles Police Department.


