

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of \$30,000 to fund the renewal of the contract for Ms. Joan Brody.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of funding for the renewal of the contract for Ms. Joan Brody valued at \$30,000, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated August 20, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve relative to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of \$30,000 to fund the renewal of the contract for Ms. Joan Brody. The LAPD reports that the donation is to fund the renewal of the contract of Ms. Joan Brody and will benefit the LAPD. Under the 2015 Grant Development Consulting Project, Ms. Joan Brody will continue to work with the LAPD to proactively seek additional discretionary county, state, federal and private funding. She will also provide the Grants Section with her expertise in the development of the Section's operational and organizational goals related to acquiring new grants and managing existing ones. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve relative to the acceptance of the donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of \$30,000 to fund the renewal of the contract for Ms. Joan Brody, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
