PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the donation of operational support for the Crime Analysis and Mapping System for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of operational support for the Crime Analysis and Mapping System valued at \$19,988, from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated October 1, 2015, attached to the Council file, the LAPD recommends that the Board approve the donation of operational support for the Crime Analysis and Mapping System from the Los Angeles Police Foundation for the benefit of the LAPD. The LAPD reports that the donation is for the benefit of the Department and will provide professional services from Environmental Systems Research Institute, Incorporated (ESRI) for assistance with ongoing maintenance and development of the Crime Analysis and Mapping System. This system is utilized by the Department Computer Statistics Division (COMPSTAT) Crime Analysis Unit for crime analysis, statistical and mapping visualization. The vendor, ESRI, is the developer of the Crime Analysis and Mapping System and best suited for modifying and upgrading the system to supported levels and will enhance the current system to include field interview and traffic citation information. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve the donation of operational support for the Crime Analysis and Mapping System for the benefit of the LAPD, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
