PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of the solicited donation from Federal Excess Property 1033 Program of military items valued at \$1,149,114.40.

Recommendation for Council action:

ACCEPT the donation of military items valued at \$1,149,114.40, from the Federal Excess Property 1033 Program for the benefit of enhancing operational capabilities, and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated June 30, 2015, attached to the Council file, the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) recommends that the Board approve the acceptance of the solicited donation from Federal Excess Property 1033 Program of military items valued at \$1,149,114.40. The LAPD reports that The Military Property Acquisition Team, Incident Command Post Unit, Emergency Operations Division, is responsible for acquiring excess military property from the Department of Defense under an existing agreement with the Federal Excess Property 1033 Program. The donation will be distributed to various entities in the LAPD to enhance operational capabilities. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee recommended that Council approve the acceptance of the solicited donation from Federal Excess Property 1033 Program of military items valued at \$1,149,114.40, as recommended by the Board of Police Commissioners, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
