## DISCUSSION

The Los Angeles Police Foundation (LAPF) will provide the funding for the Juvenile Impact Program (JIP) hosted by the Los Angeles Police Department (Department). The JIP is modeled on the concept of a public-private partnership to identify and provide intervention for students and youths who are at great risk of joining gangs or engaging in criminal activity. The

program's multiple components, including a strong parental teaching component, make it unique. The classes are taught by Department officers and certified counselors, using proactive and innovative techniques to influence the youth in a positive direction.

The LAPF funding will offset the cost to the Department for overtime for the officers involved in the program. Additionally, the donation will be used for graduation and classroom supplies, uniforms, instructor fees and teachers' pay. No expressed or implied commitments or promises were made to the donor or representatives of the donor. The donor will not receive any preferential treatment, endorsement, or recommendation; and the donor is not allowed the use of any Department patents.

Administrative Services Bureau has reviewed the donation and determined that it has been submitted in accordance with Section 5.467 et seq. of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, which provides for the receipt and acceptance of donations to the Los Angeles Police Department.
