COMMUNICATION FROM CHAIR, PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE relative to the donation of cybercrime investigation courses for the benefit of the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD).

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the LAPD to accept the donation of cybercrime investigation courses valued at \$116,500.00 from the Los Angeles Police Foundation, and thank the donor for this generous gift.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the LAPD. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

<u>Community Impact Statement</u>: None submitted.

## **SUMMARY**

In a report to the Board of Police Commissioners dated March 27, 2015, LAPD requests authority to accept a donation of cybercrime investigation courses. LAPD reports that the classes will provide Department personnel with a fundamental understanding of cybercrime and how to investigate its occurrences. The donation also includes two Mobile Device Forensic classes which will provide Department personnel with POST certification for the seizure and examination of mobile devices. This certification is required for court proceedings. On March 31, 2015, the Board approved LAPD's request.

At the Public Safety Committee meeting held June 12, 2015, the Committee Chair recommended that Council authorize LAPD to accept this donation.
