ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE REPORT relative to incorporating Sheltered Market Place provisions into the City of Los Angeles Local Business Preference Program.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Price - Krekorian):

REQUEST the City Attorney to:

- a. Undertake a review of the Small Business Enterprise Program and the efforts conducted in the City's proprietary departments to determine the feasibility of implementing a comparable program in Council-controlled districts regarding the Sheltered Market Place approach.
- b. Review the Portland and San Diego models as well as explore a category for women-owned businesses.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary

At the public hearing held on August 25, 2015, the Economic Development Committee considered Motion (Price - Krekorian) relative to incorporating Sheltered Market Place provisions into the City of Los Angeles Local Business Preference Program.
