| <b>Purpose:</b> The Office of the City Attorney requests authority to accept grant funding from the California Office of Emergency Services. Funding in the amount of \$192,233 will provide for the Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach (UVAO) Program. The Council previously authorized the City Attorney to accept grant funding in the amount of \$125,000 (C.F. 15-0249) for the FY 2014-15. An additional \$4,733 was accepted by Council on August 19, 2015. This request is to accept an additional \$62,500 in grant funding for a total of \$192,233 for the FY 2014-15 UVAO Program and extend the program date through March 31, 2016. |                         |                                 |                       |  |

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#### 10. Grant Award Summary

The Office of the City Attorney requests authority to accept \$192,233 in grant funding for the Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach (UVAO) program. These funds originate from the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) and pass through the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES). The UVAO program provides services to victims of crime in the underserved lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender (LGBT) community, with the goal of assisting victims in recovering from the psychological, emotional, and out-of-pocket financial losses incurred as a result of the crime, as well as increasing the victims' involvement in the criminal justice system. This new, additional amount reflects a subaward amendment to continue LGBT victim service through March 31, 2016 pending a new RFP that is being drafted for the next five year grant award cycle.

The total cost of the program is \$234,431, of which \$192,233 will be reimbursed to the City as follows: \$99,615 in salaries and \$36,569 in fringe benefits for one Witness Service Coordinator, \$2,685 for travel, \$46,771 for one full-time contracted victim advocate, \$2,362 for office supplies, \$2,231 for printing and binding and \$2,000 for the Victim Emergency Fund. The position authority for the Witness Service Coordinator is already provided through the 2014-15 Adopted Budget, therefore no additional position authorities are required.

The grant has a 20 percent matching requirement, which the City requested and was approved to be reduced to ten percent. Matching funds in the amount of \$29,308 will be satisfied through volunteer hours. In addition, the General Fund will have to bear \$12,890 in overhead costs, which includes \$4,174 for central services and \$8,716 for department administration, not reimbursed by the grant.

That the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor;

- 1. Approve and authorize the City Attorney, or his designee, to execute an amendment to the contract between the City and the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OEs) for the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program (FY 2014-15 UVAO), to increase the contract amount by \$62,500 from \$129,733 to \$192,233 for the period of October 1, 2014 to March 31, 2016, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form and legality;
- 2. Authorize the City Attorney, or his designee, to accept additional grant funding in the amount of \$62,500 from the Cal OES for the FY 2014-15 UVAO:
- 3. Authorize the Controller to:
  - a. Increase the receivable in the amount of \$62,500 within Fund 368, Department 12;
  - b. Increase appropriation account 12L401 UV Program \$62,500;
- 4. Authorize the City Aftomey to prepare Controller instructions for any necessary technical adjustments subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.

The total cost of the Underserved Victim Advocacy and Outreach Program is \$234,431, of which \$192,233 will be reimbursed by the California Office of Emergency Services for salaries, fringe benefits and expenses. The General Fund impact will be \$12,890 for overhead costs (central services and department administration), which are not reimbursed by the grant. The grant's match requirement of \$29,308 will be met through volunteer hours. The recommendations in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that budgeted appropriations will be balanced against receipts expected from this grant.
