
The Sun Valley EDA Public Improvements project (Project) includes the rehabilitation of approximately 0.95 mile of Branford Street between San Fernando Road and the entrance of the I-5 Freeway off ramp. The Department of Water and Power has agreed to fund the implementation of Green Street Elements (GSE) to this project. The GSE proposed to be added to the Project will direct stormwater from a 146-acre drainage area by diverting the stormwater into 31 drywells that will percolate the stormwater into the ground resulting in up to 93-acre-feet of water annually recharging the groundwater.


On December 16, 2014, the Water and Power Board of Commissioners authorized the execution of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Bureau of Engineering for the inclusion of the GSE on the Project and funding totaling \$2,440,000.

Action is needed to accept these funds and cause them to be deposited appropriately.


I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the Department of Water and Power to accept the amount of \$2,440,000 to implement Green Street Elements into the Sun Valley EDA Public Improvement Project, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form; and to deposit these funds into a new Account in the Engineering Special Services Fund No. 682-50 entitled "Sun Valley EDA Public Improvements - Green Street Elements."

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to make any corrections or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
