Dear Councilman Fuentes:

Regarding Los Angeles City Council Motion 15-0314 and the Department of Sanitation's report given at the September 16, 2015 Special Meeting, please keep consideration of the solar power generating project separate from the passive use/recreational trail Lopez Canyon bufferland proposed uses.

The passive use/recreational trail Lopez Canyon bufferland proposed uses have been in planning stages for decades whilst the solar power generating project is relatively new. This new use should not be tied to already existing plans. All this will do is further delay the implementation of these plans. Thus, the uses should be considered and implemented separately.

Moreover, the solar power generating project requires an Environmental Impact Report and a Conditional Use Permit. These requirements need to be uniquely considered apart from the passive use/recreational trail Lopez Canyon bufferland proposed uses as this commercial/industrial use is very different from passive/recreational use.
