PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the selection of Seventh Street Garage, Inc. to serve as the Official Police Garage (OPG) for Service Area Five.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the President, Board of Police Commissioners (Board), or designee, to negotiate and execute an OPG Towing and Storage Agreement with Seventh Street Garage, Inc. to serve as OPG for Service Area Five.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: None submitted by the Board. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on January 17, 2017, your Public Safety Committee considered a Board report relative to the selection of Seventh Street Garage, Inc. to serve as the OPG for Service Area Five. The Board reports that the OPG Review Committee comprised of one staff member from the Office of the City Administrative Officer, the City's Department of Transportation, and the Los Angeles Police Commission, rated the proposals. As prescribed in the Request for Proposals, the proposals were rated on a formal business plan, experience, history of contract compliance, customer service, honesty, and integrity.

A Commission Investigation Division background investigation of Seventh Street Garage, Inc. revealed one complaint which was unfounded. An inspection of equipment and facilities found no discrepancies. The Review Committee found that Seventh Street Garage had a history of contract compliance but their proposal lacked details in the business plan and, and customer service and employee honesty and integrity sections. The Committee awarded the Seventh Street Garage, Inc. proposal an average score of 73.0 based on a 100-point scale,

An opportunity for public comment was held. After further discussion of the matter, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation of the Board, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
