**Upon full consideration of these matters of said application and recommendations thereon by the Transportation Committee, the Council has determined that the franchises should be advertised for sale as herein provided.**

**A franchise will be awarded to responsible bidder(s) offering to pay to the City the highest cash consideration, not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500).**

**Sealed bids will be accepted by the Office of the City Clerk in Room 395, City Hall, 200 North Spring Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012, up to 10:00 am on.....No such bid will be considered unless it is accompanied by a guarantee of good faith in the form of cash deposit of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) or by a certified check for said amount, payable to the City Treasurer and certified to by some responsible bank in the City of Los Angeles. (Note: A detail description of the pipeline area is on file with the City of Los Angeles Department of Transportation at this time and may be accessed by contacting the Pipeline Division at 213-972-8441).**

Such bids will be opened, examined and publicly declared during the regular session of the Council in the John Ferraro Council Chambers, Room 340 City Hall, commencing at 10:00 am, or shortly thereafter, on ..... Thereupon, any responsible person, firm or corporation present or represented and accompanying his bid with a cash deposit or certified check equivalent to that required to be filed with sealed bids may raise the bid above the highest sealed bid declared; the latter bid may be raised by any other such bidder; and such bidding may thereafter continue until it appears to the Council that no higher bid is proposed.

The franchises will either then be struck off, sold and awarded by the Council to the highest bidder, but not for an amount less than the minimum bid herein above prescribed, or the Council will take the matter and the bids made under consideration for subsequent determination by it

as to the responsibility of the bidder and as to the adequacy of the bids. If in the judgment of the Council no adequate and responsible bid had been made, the Council may withdraw the franchise(s) from sale, or it may advertise the franchise(s) anew, and the Council reserves the right and power to do so.

All good faith guarantee deposits of unsuccessful bidders will be returned, except that the deposit of the bidder awarded the franchise will be retained. Successful bidders have five days to file the performance or surety bond required by the franchise after the award.
