Recommendations for Council action:

- 1. NOTE and FILE the BOS report dated April 17, 2015.
- 2. INSTRUCT the BOS to provide annual reports on the status of their compliance with the EPPP, to be submitted to the Council no later than 90 days following the close of each fiscal year.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: The BOS reports that approval of the recommendations will have no fiscal impact on the General Fund as the Environmentally-Preferable Purchasing Ordinance stipulates that the City of Los Angeles increase its purchase of environmentally-friendly products while remaining fiscally responsible.

At a regular meeting held on May 17, 2017, the Energy and Environment Committee considered a BOS EPPP Annual Report for Fiscal Year 2013-14. Staff from the BOS provided background information on the status of compliance with the City's EPPP.
